

## Statement from The Corporate Financial Advisor

### Local Land Charges Fees

#### Calculation of Charges with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2012.

Under Statutory Instrument 3248 9 (1) each local authority must publish a statement setting out how the charges are calculated. I have below shown the requirement of the Statutory Instrument and the method of calculation by Mendip District Council follows in bold:

a. the estimates the local authority has made under regulation 6(2) in respect of the unit charge for the following year. **The estimated total cost for Mendip has been estimated at £238,368 and the following number of requests for the year is estimated at 3136.**

b. the basis for those elements. **The cost of the service is based on budgeted costs for 2012/13. We have assessed that this is the most accurate data to project costs for 2012/13. The number of requests has been based on requests made during 2011/12.**

c. The amount of the unit charge it proposes for the following financial year. **The amount of unit charge proposed for 2012/13 is:**
