

## Notice of urgent decisions to be made by Cabinet on 23 May 2016

Made under the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012.

Decisions to be made by the Cabinet in private as a matter of urgency.

Under the Regulations, local authorities are required to publish a Notice of their intention to hold a meeting of the Cabinet in private at least 28 clear days before the meeting. Where the date by which the meeting must be held makes compliance impractical, the meeting may be held in private where agreement has been obtained from the Chairman of the Scrutiny Board.

This Notice sets out those decisions to be taken in private (or in part private) at the meeting of the Cabinet on 23 May 2016 which have not been included in previously published statutory notices, in line with the Regulations effective from 10 September 2012. In accordance with the Regulations, the Chairman of the Scrutiny Board has been consulted and has agreed for the items to be considered in private at the meeting.
