

**28 Day notice of confidential decision(s) to be made at the meeting of Cabinet on 7 October 2019**

Make under the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012.

Under the Regulations, local authorities are required to publish a Notice of their intention to hold a meeting of the Cabinet in private at least 28 clear days before the meeting. Where the date by which the meeting must be held makes compliance impractical, the meeting may be held in private where agreement has been obtained from the Chairman of the Scrutiny Board or if they are not available the Chairman of the Council.

This Notice sets out those decisions to be made at Cabinet on **7 October 2019**. In accordance with the Regulations, the Chairman of the Scrutiny Board has been consulted and has agreed for the items to be considered in private at the meeting.
