

**NOTICE OF ELECTION**  
**ELECTION OF A CITY COUNCILLOR**  
**FOR THE**  
**ST. CUTHBERT'S WARD OF THE CITY OF WELLS**

Notice is hereby given that:

1. An election is to be held for a City Councillor for the St. Cuthbert's Ward of the City of Wells.
2. Nominations papers are to be delivered to the Returning Officer, Mendip Council Offices, Asham, Cannards Grave Road, Shepton Mallet, BA4 5BT between the hours of 9.30am and 4.30pm on any day after the date of this notice but no later than 4pm on Friday 31<sup>st</sup> January 2020.
3. Forms of nomination papers may be obtained at the Election Office, Mendip District Council, Cannards Grave Road, Shepton Mallet, BA4 5BT from the undersigned, who will, at the request of any elector for the said Ward, prepare a nomination paper for signature.
4. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on THURSDAY 27 FEBRUARY 2020.
5. New applications to register to vote at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Election Office, Mendip Council Offices, Cannards Grave Road Shepton Mallet by midnight on Tuesday 11 February 2020. Applications can be made online by visiting [www.gov.uk/register-to-vote](http://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote)
6. Electors and their proxies should take note that applications for new postal votes, or cancellation of, or changes to existing applications, to be treated as an absent voter, for example different address for the ballot paper to be sent, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Election Office, Mendip District Council, Cannards Grave Road, Shepton Mallet, BA4 5BT by 5 pm on Wednesday 12 February 2020, if they are to be effective for this election.
7. Electors and their proxies should also note that applications for new proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Election Office, Mendip District Council, Cannards Grave Road, Shepton Mallet, BA4 5BT by 5pm on Wednesday 19 February 2020.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Election Office, Mendip District Council, Cannards Grave Road, Shepton Mallet, BA4 5BT by 5pm on Thursday 27 February 2020. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 19 February 2020. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 19 February 2020.
